DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS

Enersource Hydro Mississauga Inc. ("Enersource") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") dated November 27, 2009 under the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. The application requested approval to dispose of Group 1 Deferral and Variance account balances as defined by the Board's Report on Electricity Distributors' Deferral and Variance Account Review Initiative, dated July 31, 2009. Enersource proposed a two-year disposition period commencing on February 1, 2010. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2009-0405.

The Board in its Procedural Order No. 1 stated that it will adopt as intervenors in this proceeding the intervenors from the EB-2007-0706 proceeding and deemed intervenors eligible for cost awards in that proceeding to be eligible for cost awards in this proceeding.

The Board issued its Decision and Order on the application on January 29, 2010, in which it set out the process for intervenors to file their cost claims and to respond to any objections raised by Enersource.

The Board received cost claims from Energy Probe Research Foundation ("Energy Probe") and the School Energy Coalition ("SEC"). No comments were received from Enersource.

The Board finds the cost claims by Energy Probe and SEC to be reasonable and that Enersource shall reimbursed the costs, as noted below.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enersource shall immediately pay:
 - Energy Probe Research Foundation \$1,104.44; and
 - School Energy Coalition \$4,422.00.
2. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enersource shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
