Dear Ms. Walli:

Bluewater Power received its Decision and Order dated April 13, 2010 and has reviewed the draft Tariff of Rates and charges set out in Appendix A.

We have noted one issue that requires an adjustment to the proposed Rate Rider 2. Given the Bluewater Power situation with a wholesale market participant (“WMP”), the Board has determined that a separate rate rider is warranted for that customer as an interim measure until the situation undergoes a full review. The deferral account rate model that was submitted to Bluewater Power for review contains statistics for the WMP that relate to 2008. We have updated the model to 2009 forecast statistics for the WMP which is consistent with the statistics for the remaining rate classes in the applicable table. The resulting updated Rate Rider 2 values are indicated in the table below along with the Rate Rider 2 included with the OEB Decision.

The impact on the proposed Rate Rider 2 of this update in statistics is not material and is required for consistency and accuracy in our opinion. Accordingly we hereby submit that the Rate Rider 2 as proposed in the OEB Decision be amended to reflect the Rate Rider 2 submitted with this letter in order to accurately reflect the Board's intention.

A revised Deferral and Variance Account workform is attached, as well as an updated Tariff Sheet.
