In response to the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) and Energy Probes comments submitted on April 20, 2010, Essex has realized that there was an error in the revised model as outlined by VECC. The error has no impact on the residential class of customers and we estimate that there are minor changes to the other classes. Since there are no other issues to warrant additional recalculations, Essex's response is that it is reasonable to accept the draft rate order as submitted and use the correct approach during the IRM period. There were no comments received from School Energy Coalition (SEC).
