Re: Clinton Power Corporation and West Perth Power 2010 Cost of Service Applications


Dear Mr. Pickernell,

Pursuant to your letter dated April 20, 2010 regarding the status of both West Perth Power Inc. ("WPPI") and Clinton Power Corporation's ("CPC's") Cost of Service Applications for the 2010 Rate Year, we respectfully request that The Board extend the April 30, 2010 deadline to June 15, 2010 for filing within the 2010 Cost of Service window. It is important to note that neither corporation will be requesting a retroactive implementation of their decisions in recognition that the onus was upon each to meet the Board's expected time frame. In the case of CPC, rebasing is of significant importance due to various factors that have contributed to the significant under recovery of its revenue requirement which, if left unaddressed, may lead to future operational issues.

Progress has been made on both applications to date, however there have been many hurdles to overcome. Given the structure of its former service provider, historical consumption data was not available for either entity to provide Hydro One in order to complete the hourly load shape required to calculate the cost allocation data that drives the Cost of Service process. Given this significant lack of data WPPI decided to retract its original filing and CPC did not pursue its filing until a defensible methodology for cost allocation could be determined. To that end both companies have enlisted industry experts to assist in the production of cost allocation, load forecasting and weather normalization. With these steps nearing completion it is anticipated that the remainder of the application can be compiled and submitted by the proposed June 15th deadline referenced above.
