RATE ORDER

Cooperative Hydro Embrun ("Embrun" or the "Applicant") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 17, 2009 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Embrun charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2010 (the "Application"). The Board has assigned File Number EB-2009-0132 to this application.

The Board issued its Decision and Order on the application on March 19, 2010. In the Decision, the Board ordered Embrun to file a draft Rate Order reflecting the Board's findings in the Decision. The Board approved an effective date of May 1, 2010.

The Applicant filed a draft Rate Order with supporting material on April 6, 2010. No comments on the draft Rate Order were received. On April 20, 2010 Embrun filed an amended draft Rate Order separately indentified the LV charges from the distribution volumetric rate.

The Board has reviewed all the information provided and is satisfied that the Tariff of Rates and Charges accurately reflects the Board's Decision and Order.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix "A" of this Rate Order is approved effective May 1, 2010 for electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after such date.
- 2. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix "A" of this Rate Order supersedes all previous Tariff of Rates and Charges approved by the Board for the Coopérative Hydro Embrun service area, and is final in all respects.
- 3. Coopérative Hydro Embrun shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than with the first bill reflecting the new rates.

No rates and charges for the distribution of electricity and charges to meet the costs of any work or service done or furnished for the purpose of the distribution of electricity shall be made except as permitted by this schedule, unless required by the Distributor's Licence or a Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, or as specified herein.

Unless specifically noted, this schedule does not contain any charges for the electricity commodity, be it under the Regulated Price Plan, a contract with a retailer or the wholesale market price, as applicable.
