Preamble: Proposed Cooperative Development and Operation of Project with Partners

“KEI wishes to note again that it is not opposed to the involvement of other parties in this Project nor to the subsequent connection of unrelated generation facilities to this Project, on commercially reasonable terms.”

1. Please comment on the process by which generation customers will be allotted the transformation capacity of this project, and how it is consistent with the principles of non-discriminatory access.
2. Please explain how the connected customers would be charged for services provided by this project.

Preamble: The Project is Being Proposed in Response to an Identified Need in the Market

“If the Project is approved and ultimately constructed, KEI anticipates that it would ultimately make a value based transfer of the Project to Chatham-Kent Hydro Inc if Chatham-Kent Hydro Inc. is amenable to acquiring the Project on this basis.”

3. In the event that Kruger Energy is unable to transfer these assets to Chatham-Kent Hydro Inc., how does Kruger intend to operate this system?
4. Under the circumstances proposed in Question 3, above, would Kruger seek to become a licensed distributor?
5. Under the circumstances proposed in Question 3, above, who would own and operate the connection feeders to customers?
6. Would load customers be permitted to connect to this project?
