RE: Five Nations Energy Inc. – 2010 Transmission Rates Application
Board File No. EB-2009-0387 (Information Request Responses)

We are counsel to Five Nations Energy Inc. (“FNEI”) in the above-noted matter. Please find enclosed FNEI’s responses to information requests (“IRs”) from Board Staff and Energy Probe. Electronic “live” versions of certain IR responses are being provided as requested.

Please note that the responses to Board Staff IR 21(a), 22(b) and (c), and 23(a), (b) and (c) are being filed in confidence because they contain customer-specific load data. Each of these responses deals with FNEI’s charge determinants.

While three of FNEI’s four transmission customers are electricity distributors whose load data is made public (via rate proceedings, etc.), the load data of FNEI’s other customer (De Beers Canada Inc., hereinafter “De Beers”) is not public information. Because De Beers’ load data is private commercial information, FNEI cannot disclose it (nor can FNEI disclose FNEI’s total load data, which would enable a person to discern De Beers’ load data via simple subtraction). Consequently, this filing contains two documents:

- FNEI’s full responses to Energy Probe IRs (no confidential information); and,
- FNEI’s responses to Board Staff IRs, with the responses to Board Staff IR 21(a), 22(b) and (c), and 23(a), (b) and (c) redacted.

A separate confidential filing will be made today containing the full responses to Board Staff IRs (i.e., an unredacted version containing the full responses to Board Staff IR 21(a), 22(b) and (c), and 23(a), (b) and (c)).
