Re: EB-2010-0002/Hydro One Networks Inc. ("HONI")
Application for Transmission Revenue Requirement and Rates for 2011 and 2012

We are counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada ("Council"). We have been instructed by our client to request intervenor status in this application.

The Council is a non-profit, public interest organization which represents the interests of the broad array of residential consumers of electricity in Ontario. The outcome of the application will have an impact on the rates paid by residential consumers for electricity. In addition, this will be the first opportunity for residential consumers to assess the cost implications, for HONI and, therefore, its ratepayers, of the implementation of the *Green Energy and Green Economy Act* on HONI's transmission system. It is, therefore, important that residential consumers be represented in the matter.

The Council intends to seek an order of costs, at the conclusion of the matter. The Council has been an active participant in most, if not all, of the applications of HONI for approval of rate changes. In all of those proceedings the Council has been found eligible for an award of costs.
