## **DECISION AND ORDER**

The Board received an application on April 13, 2006 from Beaver Power Corporation seeking an amendment to Schedule 1 of its Electricity Generation Licence EG-2002-0408. The Board assigned this application file no. EB-2006-0082.

The requested amendment is to:

- delete Carmichael Falls Generating Station ("GS") and Nagagami GS from the list of facilities for which Beaver Power Corporation is the licensed owner; and
- revise "owned" to "owned and operated" for Aux Sables GS and Serpent River GS.

In connection with this application, the Board has received an electricity generation licence application (Board file no. EB-2006-0070) from Carmichael Limited Partnership for Carmichael Falls GS. Similarly, the Board has received an electricity generation licence application (Board file no. EB-2006-0072) from Algonquin Power (Nagagami) Limited Partnership for Nagagami GS. Beaver Power Corporation has now assumed responsibility for the operations of Aux Sables GS and Serpent River GS from its affiliated company, Great Lakes Power Limited. Accordingly, Great Lakes Power Limited has filed an application (Board file no. EB-2006-0083) to amend its licence to reflect the new arrangement.

The amendment is granted as requested.

In granting this amendment, I have proceeded without a hearing as I am satisfied that no person other than the applicant will be adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of this proceeding.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Schedule 1 of Beaver Power Corporation's Electricity Generation Licence EG-2002-0408 is amended in accordance with Schedule 1 to the attached amended licence.

Under section 7(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, this decision may be appealed to the Board within 15 days.
