Notice of Application – Electricity Transmission Revenue Requirement Change – Hydro One Networks Inc.

The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) is the voice of Ontario's local distribution companies (LDCs). The EDA represents the interests of over 80 publicly and privately owned LDCs in Ontario.

The EDA intends to participate in the Board's hearing of Hydro One's application seeking approval for changes to Ontario uniform transmission rates with effect from January 1, 2011 and January 1, 2012. The customers of Ontario's LDCs are the final link in the electricity supply chain and thus are impacted by any increase in the uniform transmission rates. As the representative of the LDCs in Ontario, and in the interests of consumers, the EDA wishes to participate in the proceedings of Hydro One's application. Although the EDA does not anticipate filing for cost awards, it reserves the right to request cost eligibility for its participation if additional resources become necessary at a later stage in the proceeding.
