RE: EB-2010-0002 – Hydro One Networks Inc. ("HONI") 2011 & 2012 Revenue Requirement Application Late Request for Intervenor Status

We are counsel to Five Nations Energy Inc. ("FNEI"), and file this letter on their behalf. FNEI is a not-for-profit, licensed transmitter in Ontario.

FNEI requests intervenor status in the above-mentioned proceeding. The rationale for FNEI's late request is that FNEI has only recently become aware of the "High Five" proposal advanced by the Association of Major Power Consumers of Ontario ("AMPCO") in this proceeding, and of HONI's motion to have that issue heard in a generic proceeding, as set out in Procedural Order No. 1, issued June 28, 2010. As one of the four licensed transmitters in Ontario whose revenue requirement forms part of the Uniform Transmission Rates, FNEI has a direct interest in the resolution of this issue.
