Re: EB-2010-0055 Union Gas. 2011 DSM Plan – GEC Late Intervention

The Green Energy Coalition (GEC) hereby seeks to intervene late in this matter and requests that it be found eligible for costs. GEC had assumed that the 2011 plan was simply an extension of the earlier plan and was formula driven and since we had obtained satisfactory results from our consultations with Union on details, we had not intervened. However, with the issuance of the Minister's directive of July 5th which calls for an enhanced low income DSM program for 2011 and which also calls for heightened efforts on DSM overall, we recognize that the Board may wish to respond to these directives in this docket, during the current or a subsequent phase of the proceeding. GEC would like the opportunity to participate in any such consideration. I have today spoken to Mr. Ripley, Union's Manager of Regulatory Applications, and he has indicated that Union has no objection to our request.

GEC understands that the deadline for interrogatories has passed and we would not be seeking any accommodation in that regard.

The GEC is comprised of the David Suzuki Foundation, Eneract, Greenpeace Canada, Sierra Club of Canada and WWF-Canada. All of the GEC's member groups are charitable or non-profit organizations active on environmental and energy policy matters.
