We are counsel for the School Energy Coalition. Pursuant to Procedural Order #1 in this proceeding, this letter constitutes the responding submissions by the School Energy Coalition on the Draft Issues List.

We note that we have not seen a submission from Hydro One with respect to the Draft Issues List, and we do not know the Applicant's reaction to the amendments we have proposed in our July 6<sup>th</sup> letter.

Having reviewed the submissions of AMPCO, CCC, CME, and VECC, we do not think it necessary to change our previous submissions, which seem to be supported directly or indirectly by all who have commented on those areas.

We do note CME's expansion of the consumer affordability issue. We are also very concerned about that issue, particularly in the context of the many pressures on energy bills at this time. We hope that the expanded scope is already included in the Draft Issues List, but if it is not, we agree with CME that it should be added.
