Pursuant to *Procedural Order No. 2*, please find enclosed Pollution Probe's submissions regarding confidentiality in this matter.

For the Board's reference, Pollution Probe's submissions are limited to certain redactions in the "Economic Feasibility Assessment of Darlington Refurbishment" dated November 13, 2009, which is located at Exhibit D2, Tab 2, Schedule 1, Attachment 4. Pollution Probe submits that these specific redactions do not meet any of the limited confidentiality exceptions detailed in Appendix B of the Board's *Practice Direction on Confidentiality*, and they ought to be public. For example, the information contained in these redactions is of a high-level summary rather than specifics that would be prejudicial to OPG if they were public. Pollution Probe also notes that CWIP for Darlington is expected to be a key issue in this proceeding, and thus high-level numbers regarding the

underlying economic analysis (including LUEC numbers and comparisons) ought to be public and available to be tested publicly in a non-confidential forum. Pollution Probe thus submits that the balance in this confidentiality situation favours the public interests of transparency and openness for such high-level information, and this information should be part of the full public record.
