Board File No. EB-2010-0008 Payment Amounts for Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s Prescribed Facilities Revised Draft Issues List

Pursuant to the Board's letter in respect of the Revised Draft Issues List, dated July 7, 2010, Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) submits that in general it is supportive of the Revised List. Energy Probe does wish to be assured that two areas of potential inquiry lie within the Revised List as currently worded.

Energy Probe will wish to pose questions in respect of how interest expense is deducted for tax purposes in each of the nuclear and hydro segments of Operating Costs. Issue 6.11 appears to be appropriate to pursue interest interrogatories, but if not, we believe the Board should add an issue to deal with this.

As well, Energy Probe will wish to pose questions in respect of Nuclear Waste Management and Decommissioning Liabilities. Among other events, a new Ontario Nuclear Funds Agreement applicable to the 2012 – 2016 period is expected to be completed in 2011. And so, Energy Probe wishes to pursue interrogatories dealing with OPG's cost of meeting current regulatory standards and explore a sensitivity analysis of the implications of OPG's liabilities. Issue 8.2 appears to be appropriate to pursue interrogatories in these matters, but if not, we believe the Board should add an issue to deal with this.
