Hydro One Networks Inc Motion to Sever Review of the "High 5 Proposal"**

The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) is the voice of Ontario's local distribution companies (LDCs). The EDA represents the interests of over 80 publicly and privately owned LDCs in Ontario.

The EDA notes that the AMPCO's High 5 proposal is likely to have a large impact on distributors' customers, specifically Residential & General Service customers with less than 5000 kW. If the High 5 proposal is approved, it would significantly shift the transmission costs from AMPCO's members to distributors' customers. Therefore, the proposal needs a thorough examination requiring appropriate notice to all affected parties so that stakeholders could focus solely on this complex issue to give it the best attention possible.

Given that it is a material issue that requires a thorough hearing, the EDA recommends a separate generic proceeding for review and assessment of the High 5 proposal.
