Notice of Application and Hearing

We are in receipt of your Letter of Direction dated November 15, 2007 and accompanying Notice of Application and Hearing.

PowerStream submitted its Application on October 30, 2007 indicating that an addendum would be forthcoming by November 30, 2007 incorporating the Board's October 29, 2007 direction on the updating of transmission rates. It was indicated in the letter that PowerStream, as a result of owning most transformer stations, needed some time to calculate the appropriate rates.

PowerStream will be submitting the revised filing by November 23, 2007 incorporating new lower retail transmission rates that significantly reduce total bill impacts. (For clarity the entire filing will be resubmitted.)

PowerStream believes it would be confusing to rate payers to publish two different Notices of Application and Hearing and feels it would be best to file a single Notice of Application and Hearing based on the November 23, 2007 application.


We respectfully request that the Board withdraw this letter of direction and provide a new one based on the November 23, 2007 application.

Please note that the customer bill impacts referenced in the Notice of Application are significant and would change as follows:

Typical Residential (1,000 kWh per month)	Range from 3.0% decrease to 3.2% increase depending on rate zone	Range from 5.3% decrease to 0.8% increase depending on rate zone
Typical Small Commercial (2,000 kWh per month)	Range from 2.2% decrease to 3.3% increase depending on rate zone	Range from 4.3% decrease to 1.1% increase depending on rate zone



**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN
ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE**

PowerStream Inc.

The Ontario Energy Board has received an application on October 30, 2007 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that PowerStream Inc. charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2008. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2007-0850. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of PowerStream Inc.'s customers.

Any change to the rates that PowerStream Inc. charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

PowerStream Inc. indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate change in the electricity bill ranging from a decrease of ~~3.0%~~ to an increase of ~~3.2%~~, depending on their rate zone. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would see an approximate change in the electricity bill ranging from a ~~2.2%~~ decrease to an increase of ~~3.3%~~, depending on their rate zone.

How to see PowerStream Inc.'s Pre-filed Evidence

Copies of the application are available for inspection at the Board's offices in Toronto and on its website, www.oeb.gov.on.ca, and at the PowerStream Inc. offices.

How to Participate

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

1. Send a Letter with your Comments to the Board

Your letter with comments will be provided to the Board members deciding the application, and will be part of the public record for the application. Your letter must be received by the Board no later than **30 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts letters of comment by either post or e-mail at the addresses below.

2. Become an Observer

Observers do not actively participate in the proceeding but monitor the progress of the proceeding by receiving documents issued by the Board. You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in this proceeding. If you become an observer, you need to contact the applicant and others in order to receive documents that they file in this proceeding and they may charge you for this. Most documents filed in this application will also be available on the Board's website. Your request for observer status must be made in writing and be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. The Board accepts observer request letters by either post or e-mail at the addresses below; however, two paper copies are also required. You must also provide a copy of your letter to the applicant.

3. Become an Intervenor

You may ask to become an intervenor if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Intervenor status is eligible to receive evidence and other material submitted by participants in the hearing. Likewise, intervenors will be expected to send copies of any material they file to all parties to the hearing.

Your request for intervenor status must be made by letter of intervention and be received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication or service date of this notice. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the outcome of this proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.

The Board intends to proceed with this application by way of written hearing. The Board will not hold a written hearing if a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing, your letter of intervention must include reasons why an oral hearing is necessary.

If you already have a user ID, please submit your intervention request through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca. Additionally, two paper copies are required. If you do not have a user ID, please visit the Board's website under e-filings and fill out a user ID password request. For instructions on how to submit and naming conventions please refer to the RESS Document Guidelines found at www.oeb.gov.on.ca, e-Filing Services. The Board also accepts interventions by e-mail, at the address below, and again, two additional paper

copies are required. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit their intervention request on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies.
