DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS

Union Gas Limited ("Union") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board on June 11, 2010 under the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* seeking approval to modify its current approved C1 rate schedule to accommodate firm transportation service from Dawn to the Dawn -TCPL interconnect, effective November 1, 2010. Union filed an update to the Application on July 15, 2010. The Board has assigned the Application file number EB-2010-0207.

The Board issued its Decision and Order on the Application on August 12, 2010, in which it set out the process for the Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters ("CME") to file its cost claim and to respond to any objections raised by Union. A cost claim was submitted by CME on August 23, 2010.

On August 23, 2010, Union filed a submission stating that CME's cost claim was within the cost assessment guidelines and Union had no objection to the claim.

The Board has reviewed the cost claim filed by CME and finds that CME is eligible for 100% of its reasonably incurred costs of participating in this proceeding. The Board finds that CME's claim is reasonable and should be reimbursed by Union.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Union shall immediately pay Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters \$2,306.64.
- 2. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Union shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
