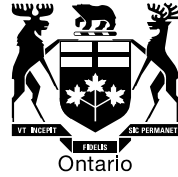

**Issue 1.3**

**Is the overall increase in 2011 and 2012 revenue requirement reasonable given the overall bill impact on consumers?**

1. The evidence filed by CME indicates that electricity costs will be increasing substantially in the next 5 years due to a number of factors. As the EB-2010-0008 proceeding is a payment amounts case which deals with only the revenue requirement and payment amounts for OPG's regulated generation facilities, how does CME propose the Board apply this evidence in the present proceeding?
2. Has CME used an estimate of inflation over the 2011 to 2015 period in the analysis? What is the inflation rate that is estimated over this time period?
