**Re: EB-2010-0219: Review of Electricity Distribution Cost Allocation Policy.**  
**Rogers Cable Communications Inc. (Rogers) Intent to Participate.**

We are counsel to Rogers in respect of the captioned proceeding. This letter is written to indicate Rogers' intent to participate in this review, in response to the Board's September 2, 2010 Notice herein.

**Description of the Participant.**

Rogers is an integrated cable and communications company that receives electricity for its cable signal amplification power supplies from distributors throughout Ontario. Rogers' power supplies are connected to local distribution systems, and are generally served on an unmetered basis (as "unmetered scattered load", or "USL").

**Relevance of the Review to the Intervenor.**

The Board's September 2, 2010 Notice indicates that this review will include consideration of cost allocation policy for USL customers. Rogers has been active in previous Board proceedings - policy proceedings and rate proceedings - on this topic, in pursuit of just and reasonable rates

for USL customers. In Rogers' view, just and reasonable USL rates are established by ensuring that the revenue derived from those rates recovers the properly identified costs to serve USL customers, no more and no less.

**Costs.**

Rogers does not intend to seek costs in this proceeding.
