**Review of Electricity Distribution Cost Allocation Policy**

In response to the September 2, 2010, notification by Ontario Energy Board (OEB) regarding the Review of Electricity Distribution Cost Allocation Policy, the Town of Oakville respectfully requests to be included in the consultation process as a participant and stakeholder; and to be granted the intervener status.

The 2007 Distribution Cost Allocation Model in unmetered scatter loads, specifically in street lighting and sentinel lighting, has had a major impact to electricity cost borne by Oakville. As Oakville is mostly urbanized, the upcoming review of the distribution cost allocation has to be accurately calculated and implemented for the urban settings in Oakville.

We also wish to request cost eligibility in this OEB process. We are seeking an expert analyst or consultant in street lighting and electricity industry to represent Oakville in the consultation and review process. The name and credentials of this expert will be disclosed to OEB shortly.
