The Transmission Unit Cost chart is based on analysis of data submitted by the benchmarking company First Quartile Consulting.

The equation utilized by First Quartile Consulting equals (Capital plus O&M Spending) divided by Asset Value. The unit costs are calculated as a 3 year average (2006-2008) using Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) definitions and data to compare Hydro One's results to those of comparable U.S. utilities. The FERC definitions of costs (Capital, Operating and Maintenance), unlike the CEA, excludes "fringe benefits" (e.g. pension, health benefits, unemployment insurance, etc.) and costs associated with transport, work equipment and information technology (IT). In addition, the FERC definition of Gross Fixed Assets, unlike CEA, excludes assets associated with transport, work equipment and information technology. As a result, cross-study comparisons are unreliable.
