Exhibit 1 Tab 1 Schedule 3 is based upon Hydro One data as defined by the Canadian Electricity Association (CEA) whereby the Capital, Operating and Maintenance costs <u>include</u> "fringe benefits" (e.g. pension, health benefits, unemployment insurance, etc.) and costs associated with transportation, work equipment and information technology (IT). In addition, the CEA definition of Gross Fixed Assets <u>includes</u> assets associated with transport, work equipment and information technology.

 Miscellaneous Exhibit K2.1, Schedule C, page 27 is based upon an analysis of data from the First Quartile Consulting benchmarking association of comparable U.S. utilities. The unit costs are a 3 year average from 2006 to 2008 that are based on Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) definitions whereby Capital, Operating and Maintenance costs exclude fringe benefits (e.g. pension, health benefits, unemployment insurance, etc.) and costs associated with transportation, work equipment and IT. Also, the FERC definition of Gross Fixed Assets excludes assets associated with transport, work equipment and information technology.
