Re: Reporting Requirements in Relation to the Board's Determination Under Section 1.2.1 of the Standard Supply Service Code to Mandate Time-of-Use Pricing for Regulated Price Plan Customers Board File No. EB-2010-0218
Request for Filing Exemption

Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. ("Milton Hydro") is writing to the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") to request an exemption from the monthly reporting requirements in the above matter. Milton Hydro provides the following in support of this request.

On June 22, 2007 Milton Hydro filed its Smart Meter Investment Plan ("SMIP") with the Ontario Energy Board. Milton Hydro has completed 100% of the installation of all smart meters as set out in the SMIP and continues to install smart meters on all new Residential and small General Service customers.

Milton Hydro was one of the first distributors to begin testing with the Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") and signed off on the Meter Data Management and Repository Self-Certification for Cutover Readiness, SME_Form_0008 v0.10 on April 4, 2008. Milton Hydro is registered with the Smart Meter Entity's ("SME") MDM/R under ORG77250 and has been sending and receiving customer data through the MDM/R since April 2008.

In September 2005 Milton Hydro began billing over 2,000 Residential and small General Service customers on Time of Use ("TOU") electricity prices and is now billing 100% of Regulated Price Plan ("RPP") eligible customers on TOU electricity prices.

The monthly reporting is required by the OEB in order to monitor the status of the deployment of smart meters in a distributors service area; the integration of a distributors meters and systems with the provincial meter data management and meter data repository or MDM/R; and the distributors plans for implementing TOU and billing for RPP-eligible consumers. Milton Hydro has deployed 100% of its smart meters; is fully integrated with the MDM/R; and is billing 100% of its RPP-eligible consumers on TOU electricity prices.

Milton Hydro submits that it has met all of the objectives of the Board's Determination under Section 1.2.1 of the Standard Supply Service Code to Mandate Time-of-Use Pricing for Regulated Price Plan Customers and as such Milton Hydro respectfully requests to be exempt from the remaining monthly reporting requirements under Board File No. EB-2010-0218.
