...Kingston Hydro indicates that if the application is approved as filed, Residential customers consuming 800kWh per month would experience an increase of approximately 26.5% in their delivery charges.....There would be an increase of \$7.17 per month on their total bill. General Service customers consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50kW would experience an increase of approximately 16.5% in their delivery charges. there would be an increase of \$9.78 per month on their total bill. THE PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE DELIVERY COMPONENT OF THE BILL IS SEPARATE FROM OTHER POTENTIAL CHANGES TO ELECTRICITY BILLS, WHICH COULD INCLUDE CHANGES TO THE "ELECTRICITY" CHARGES, CHARGES TO TRANSMISSION CHARGES AND CHANGES TO OTHER COMPONENTS OF THE BILL. This application deals only with the potential change in the delivery component of the bill that may result from changes in the distribution rates.

I am opposed to the high % to be charged for residential (26.5%) vs. General Service Customers (16.5%) .
