AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 3

Newmarket – Tay Power Distribution Ltd. ("Newmarket – Tay" or "the Applicant") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"), received on July 22, 2010 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, seeking approval for changes to the rates that Newmarket – Tay charges for electricity distribution.

The Board issued Procedural Order No. 1 on September 8, 2010 approving the intervenors and ordering Board staff and intervenors wishing to comment on the Draft Issues List to file with the Board any comments no later than Tuesday September 14, 2010.

The Board issued Procedural Order No. 2 on September 22, 2010 approving the Issues List and setting dates for interrogatories and responses. Interrogatory responses were due on October 22, 2010.

By way of a letter dated October 22, 2010, Newmarket – Tay requested an extension of the deadline for responses to November 3, 2010. The Board has determined that it will grant Newmarket – Tay's request.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Newmarket – Tay file with the Board and deliver to the intervenors its responses to the interrogatories no later than Wednesday November 3, 2010.

All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2010-0269, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>www.oeb.gov.on.ca</u>. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the <u>BoardSec@oeb.gov.on.ca</u>. If the web portal is not available you may email sinct available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the Board's web portal an e-mail is not required.

All communications shall be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
