31 For clarity, OPG will not be required to make any contribution of additional funds to  
32 satisfy the requirements of the NFWA Trust Funds. OPG will designate existing funds  
33 within the ONFA Used Fuel Segregated Fund to satisfy the requirements of the Trust  
34 Funds.
