In reply to the Board's letter dated December 5, 2007 and the attached Board Staff interrogatories for the above proceeding, please find Orillia Power's responses to the Board Staff's interrogatories below:

**Ref.: 2008 IRM Model, Sheet 2 (2007 Rate Classes)**

**Question 1: Standby Power**

A review of the 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the standby power rate classification should include the descriptor "INTERIM APPROVAL", however Orillia Power's 2008 model does not reflect this.

**Response 1:**

Orillia Power confirms that "Standby Power – INTERIM APPROVAL" is in its current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges and this should continue to be applied for 2008 rates. Please include this correction in the Board Order for 2008 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges.

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**Ref.: 2008 IRM Model, Sheet 3 (2007 Tariff Sheet)**

**Question 2: Monthly Rates and Charges for Unmetered Scattered Load**

A review of your current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge should include the descriptor “(per connection)”, however Orillia Power’s 2008 model does not reflect this.

**Response 2:**

Question 5: Specific Service Charges for Non-Payment of Account


