AND IN THE MATTER OF a request by Sarnia Solar Farm No.2 L.P. pursuant to section 77(5) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* to cancel electricity generation licence EG-2009-0016.

DECISION AND ORDER

Sarnia Solar Farm No.2 L.P. ("Sarnia") filed an application on September 3, 2010 with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* ("the Act") to amend its electricity generation licence EG-2009-0016 and a request to subsequently cancel its electricity generation licence EG-2009-0016 pursuant to section 77(5) of the Act. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2010-0273.

The requested amendment is the removal from Schedule 1 of Sarnia's electricity generation licence the generation facilities Sarnia Solar 1, Sarnia Solar 3, Sarnia Solar 4 and Sarnia Solar 6 located in Sarnia, Ontario. The requested amendment would recognize the purchase of the generation facilities by another generator licensed by the Board.

Sarnia has also requested subsequent cancellation of the licence EG-2009-0016 as all the facilities currently listed in the Schedule 1 of its licence will have been sold to another party.

I have proceeded to decide the application without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding, and the applicant has consented to disposing of the application without a hearing.

I find the requested licence amendment to be unnecessary. The removal of all generation facilities from Schedule 1 means that Sarnia no longer requires a licence. The licence will be cancelled when the Board receives confirmation from the applicant that the facilities have been transferred to the purchaser.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Sarnia Solar Farm No. 2 L.P.'s electricity generation licence EG-2009-0016 will be cancelled when the Board receives confirmation from the applicant that the all the generation facilities listed in Schedule 1 of the licence have been transferred to the purchaser.
