Pursuant to Hydro One Network Inc.'s (Hydro One) and Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc.'s Notice of Application and Hearing posted on November 19, 2010, Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited (THESL) requests Intervenor Status in the EB-2010-0332 and EB-2010-0331 proceedings.

THESL is an electricity distributor operating under Licence ED-2002-0497. As an OEB-regulated utility, THESL has a direct interest in all matters of jurisdiction, substance and procedure with respect to the regulation of electricity in Ontario, and in decisions of the Board which may affect THESL's operation in the Ontario electricity market. In particular, as a customer of Hydro One, THESL (and its customers) will be affected by the Board's decision on whether to allow CDM programs to be funded by all provincial ratepayers through the Global Adjustment Mechanism through the IESO billing.

THESL reserves the right to be heard, to appear by or with counsel of its choice, to cross-examine on all subject matters in this hearing that may relate to its interest, to advance evidence on specific matters that are relevant to this proceeding and to present argument.

THESL requests electronic copies of Hydro One's prefiled evidence. THESL further requests to be included in the distribution list for any documents, correspondence or updates related to this proceeding.

THESL does not intend to seek an award of costs in this proceeding and will be governed by the decision of the Board to hold a written or oral hearing in this matter.
