### **DECISION AND ORDER**

Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG") filed an application on August 20, 2010 with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* to amend Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence, EG-2003-0104.

OPG requested that its licensed list of facilities be amended from own and operate to operate only for the following generating stations:

1. Kipling Generating Station;
2. Harmon Generating Station;
3. Smoky Falls Generating Station; and
4. Little Long Generating Station.

OPG also requested that the amendment be effective on the same date that the Board issues an electricity generation licence to the Lower Mattagami Energy Limited Partnership ("LMELP").

OPG stated that the ownership of these facilities was transferred from OPG to LMELP in the fall of 2010. In a related application, LMELP applied to the Board for a new electricity generation licence to own these generation stations on August 20, 2010. The

change of ownership was related to the redevelopment of the stations undertaken in response to a directive from the Minister of Energy.

I have proceeded to decide the application without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding, and the applicant has consented to disposing of this matter without a hearing.

I find that it is in the public interest to grant the requested amendment to Schedule 1 of the licence.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

Schedule 1 of the electricity generation licence EG-2003-0104 is amended to remove the ownership authorization for the Kipling, Harmon, Smoky Falls and Little Long Generation Stations. The amended licence will be issued on the same date the Board issues LMELP an electricity generation licence to own these generation stations. The amended licence is attached to this Order.
