With more than 50 years' experience TransCanada Corporation is a leader in the responsible development and reliable operation of North American energy infrastructure including natural gas and oil pipelines, power generation and gas storage facilities. In addition to over \$40 billion of assets, TransCanada has a superior growth portfolio that will see us invest approximately \$22 billion in a number of energy infrastructure projects throughout North America. The majority of these projects are under construction and expected to be completed over the next three years. Furthermore, TransCanada Power Transmission (Ontario) L.P.'s ("TPT") affiliate, TransCanada Energy Ltd., is the owner and operator of the Wildhorse Transmission Line running from Northern Montana across the international border to an interconnection with the Express Pipeline at the Wild Horse Station. The Wildhorse Transmisison Line, operational since 1998, is a 69 kilovolt three-phase, 60 hertz radial power line.

TransCanada has a long history in the development and operation of large-scale linear energy infrastructure projects, including, for instance, the recently completed Keystone System. Keystone's first phase was highlighted by the 864 kilometre conversion of natural gas pipeline to crude oil pipeline and construction of an innovative bullet line that brings the crude oil non-stop from Canada through North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri and Illinois to market hubs in the U.S. Midwest. The US\$12 billion Keystone pipeline will play an important role in linking a secure and growing supply of Canadian crude oil with the largest refining markets in the United States, significantly improving North American security supply. Upon completion, the Keystone System will be comprised of the 3,461 kilometre Keystone Pipeline and the proposed 2,673 kilometre Keystone Gulf Coast Expansion Project.

Through its parent companies and affiliates, TPT has access to an incredibly skilled and diverse workforce with expertise in gas, power and oil development, construction and operation. Of note to this application and as mentioned above, TransCanada is currently engaged in the regulatory process to develop, construct and operate a 500 kV high-voltage direct current transmission projects (Zephyr Power Transmission Project) that would directly benefit the states it crosses and consumers in the southwestern U.S. and make a substantial contribution to achieving state RPS and federal climate change objectives. On May 20, 2010, TransCanada announced the results of the Zephyr open season, an industry first for interstate merchant transmission.

In addition, an affiliate of TPT, TransCanada Maine Wind Development Inc., is developing and will operate the Kibby Wind Project which will include 44 wind turbines and an approximately 25-mile radial 115 kV transmission line to connect the project to the Central Maine Power transmission system in Franklin County, Maine. The Kibby Wind Power Project will be the largest wind power development in New England, providing enough clean, renewable electricity for the equivalent of 50,000 average Maine homes. Moreover, the proposed \$100 million Kibby Expansion Wind Power Project along the Sisk Mountain ridgeline, proximate to the Kibby Wind Power Project, will include up to 15 three-megawatt turbines.

Another affiliate of TPT, Cartier Wind Energy Inc., was awarded six projects by Hydro-Québec Distribution representing a total of 740 MW. The six projects, three of which have already entered commercial in-service, are located in the administrative region of Gaspesie, Iles-de-la-Madeleine and the Regional County Municipality of Matane, represent an investment of more than \$1.1 billion, and will be fully commissioned by 2012.

Thus, as a developer of energy infrastructure projects across North America with a substantive and long standing

investment in the Ontario energy market, TransCanada has the technical capability and experience, and is fully qualified and committed, to carry out the activities required as a licensed transmitter to develop, own and operate transmission projects in Ontario.

The passage of the Green Energy and Green Economy Act, 2009 has created enormous demand for investment in transmission infrastructure that will enable the connection of new renewable sources of electrical supply. As noted in the OEB Staff Discussion Paper EB-2010-0059, the Ontario Power Authority has received applications for over 9,000 MW of renewable generation, and the Government of Ontario has signed an agreement to construct a further 2,500 MW of renewable generation capacity. While there is approximately 11,000 MW of renewable generation for which transmission capacity may be required, a large percentage of this generation, not to mention any other renewable generation that may come forward subsequently, cannot be met by existing or approved transmission facilities in Ontario. Accordingly, the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 has recently been amended to require licensed transmitters to develop transmission system plans to accommodate this new renewable generation and have them reviewed by the Ontario Energy Board. The Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") has recently established a Board Policy on transmission project development planning (EB-2010-0059) which encourages new entrants to build transmission infrastructure in Ontario to satisfy the demand for new transmission and also because "The Board believes that economic efficiency will best be pursued by introducing competition in transmission service to the extent possible within the current regulatory and market system."

With more than 50 years' experience, TransCanada is a leader in the responsible development and reliable operation of North American energy infrastructure, including natural gas and oil pipelines (i.e., the US \$12 billion Keystone Pipeline), power generation and gas storage facilities. TransCanada has invested approximately \$5 billion over the past several years in both nuclear and natural gas-fired generation facilities in Ontario including Bruce Power, Portlands Energy Centre and the Halton Hills Generating Station. The project development and operating experience

that TransCanada has developed over many years is now being employed in the development of electrical transmission assets. TransCanada just recently announced the successful open season for the full capacity on its proposed Zephyr Power Transmission Project. Zephyr is a 1600 kilometre, 500 kilovolt, high voltage direct current transmission line designed to move 3000 megawatts of wind-generated power from Wyoming to markets in the southwest United States at a cost of approximately US\$3.0 billion.

As TransCanada entities are long time participants in the Ontario energy sector, TPT is applying for an electricity transmission license so that it is positioned to respond to requests from the OEB to develop transmission plans and eventually construct, own and operate these facilities and bring the same innovation and commitment to the connection of new sources of cleaner and renewable electrical energy to Ontario consumers as TransCanada entities have to the other elements of the energy sector. Thus, approval of TPT's application for an electricity transmission license that will allow TransCanada to bring its vast experience in the development and operation of energy infrastructure into the Ontario market for the connection of transmission to renewable generation will improve the reliability, quality, economy and efficiency of electrical energy supply in the province.
