1. A review of your current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the General Service Less than 50 kW class is \$15.2600, however your 2008 model does not reflect this. You have entered a service charge of \$15.2615.

The Cooperative confirms that the correct amount for the General Service Less than 50 kW class is \$15.26, a typo error has been done.

2. A review of your current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the Unmetered Scattered Load class is applied on a “per customer” basis, however your 2008 model does not reflect this.

The Cooperative confirms that beside the Service Charge for the Unmetered Scattered Load class in the 2008 model, it should be (per customer).

The Cooperative omit to specify (per customer) in the 2008 model.

3. A review of your current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the Street Lighting class is applied on a “per connection” basis, however your 2008 model does not reflect this.

The Cooperative confirms that beside Service Charge for the Street lighting class in the 2008 model, it should be (per connection).

The Cooperative omit to specify (per connection) in the 2008 model.

4. A review of your current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that that the Transformer Allowance for Ownership is applied on a “\$/kW” basis, however your 2008 model does not reflect this.

The Cooperative confirms that (\$/kW) basis, it should be next to the \$ sign in the Transformer Allowance for Ownership applied in the 2008 model.

The Cooperative omit to specify (\$/kW) in the 2008 model.
