You are directed:

2. To arrange immediately for the enclosed French version of the Notice, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Commission de l'Énergie de l'Ontario" in one edition of Le Droit;

3. To immediately serve a copy of the Notice directly on:
  - all licensed transmitters;

  - Association Of Power Producers Of Ontario;
  - the Consumers Council of Canada;

- the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition;
  - the Association of Major Power Consumers of Ontario;
  - Energy Probe;
  - Pollution Probe;
  - the Schools Energy Coalition;
  - the Electricity Distributors Association; and
  - all registered intervenors and observers in the IESO's 2009 and 2010 Fees Submission for Review. (Note: Duplicate copies need not be sent.)
4. To immediately have the Notice posted, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Ontario Energy Board", along with your pre-filed evidence on the IESO website in the "Regulatory Affairs" page;
  5. To immediately have the English and French version of the Notice posted on the IESO website in the "Participant News" page. The English version is to be headed with Ontario Government logo and the words "Ontario Energy Board". The French version is to be headed with Ontario Government logo and the words "Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario";
  6. To immediately have the English and French version of the Notice e-mailed to all market participants and interested parties who are registered to receive IESO news and other communiqués;
  7. To file with the Board affidavit evidence proving the above service and publication immediately upon completion, with the relevant Notices, Application, and original post office registration receipts (where applicable), or courier confirmation lists attached as appendices. It is not necessary for the affidavits of publication to have newspaper tear sheets attached;
  8. To immediately, or as soon as it is ready, have copies of the Application, the pre-filed evidence and any additional materials as they are developed, made available for convenient public perusal at your offices; and
  9. To immediately provide a copy of the Application, the pre-filed evidence and any additional materials as they are developed, to any person upon request.
