SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION ON COST ELIGIBILITY

On December 13, 2010, the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) issued its original Decision on Cost Eligibility in relation to the Ontario Power Authority’s (“OPA”) 2011 Expenditure and Revenue Requirement Submission.

In that Decision, the Board approved the intervention requests of the Association of Power Producers of Ontario, HQ Energy Marketing Inc., the Independent Electricity System Operator, Manitoba Hydro, Ontario Power Generation, and Shell Energy North America (Canada) Inc. The Board also approved Energy Probe Research Foundation, Green Energy Coalition, Low-Income Energy Network, Pollution Probe, and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition as intervenors and determined they would be eligible for an award of costs in the proceeding. The Board accepted the Electricity Distributors Association (“EDA”) as an intervenor, but did not make a finding with respect to the cost eligibility request submitted by the EDA. The Board also accepted the Ontario

Sustainable Energy Association (“OSEA”) as an intervenor but determined that OSEA was not eligible for a cost award.

On December 14, 2010 the Board received a revised request for intervention and cost eligibility from the Canadian Energy Efficiency Alliance (“CEEA”).

The Board grants CEEA’s request for intervenor status and finds that CEEA is eligible for a cost award.
