Letter of Direction - REVISED

**Re: Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited
2008 Incentive Regulation Mechanism (2008 IRM) Rate Application

The Ontario Energy Board issued a Letter of Direction on November 12, 2007. Since you were unable to fulfill the directions within the allotted time, the Ontario Energy Board has issued a revised Notice of Application and Written Hearing relating to your 2008 IRM application. Please note that you must publish the notice within fourteen days of the date of this letter. If publication is impossible within fourteen days, you must inform the Board staff contact given at the bottom of this letter immediately.

You are directed:

- 1) To arrange immediately for the enclosed English version of the Notice, headed with the Ontario government logo and the words "Ontario Energy Board", to be published in one issue of the English language newspaper having the highest paid circulation, according to the best information available, in Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's service area. Publication must be complete within fourteen days of the receipt of this letter.

Please note that invoices regarding publication are not to be sent to the Board.

- 1) If Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited is a host distributor, to immediately, and no later than the date of publication of the Notice, serve a copy of the Notice directly on its embedded distributor(s).
- 2) To file with the Board an affidavit proving publication and, where applicable, service of the Notice immediately thereafter.
- 3) To make a copy of the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's office and on its website, if available; and,
- 4) To provide a copy of the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to any intervenor who requests a copy.

**REVISED NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING
FOR AN
ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE**

Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited

The Ontario Energy Board has received an application on October 29, 2007 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2008. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2007-0845. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's customers.

Any change to the rates that Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 3.0% decrease in the electricity bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would see an approximate 2.3% decrease in the electricity bill.

How to see Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's Application

Copies of the application are available for inspection at the Board's office in Toronto and on its website, www.oeb.gov.on.ca, and at Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's office.

How to Participate in the Rate Proceeding

The Board intends to proceed with Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited's rate change application by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any objections to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant at the addresses below no later than January 7, 2008. The Board will not be awarding costs in this matter.

Anyone who wishes information and material from the applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the applicant on or before January 21, 2008. The applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all parties who asked interrogatories no later than February 4, 2008.

Anyone who wishes to make a submission on the application must file that written submission with the Board and deliver it to the applicant by February 18, 2008. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submission(s), the written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all parties who made submissions by March 3, 2008.
