### **SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION ON COST ELIGIBILITY**

On December 13, 2010, the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) issued its original Decision on Cost Eligibility in relation to the Ontario Power Authority’s (“OPA”) 2011 Expenditure and Revenue Requirement Submission.

On December 14, 2010, the Board issued a Supplemental Cost Eligibility Decision approving the intervention and cost eligibility request by the Canadian Energy Efficiency Alliance.

On December 16, 2010, the Board issued a second Supplemental Cost Eligibility Decision approving the late intervention and cost eligibility requests by the Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters and the School Energy Coalition.

On December 21, 2010, the Board received a late intervention and cost eligibility request from the Consumers Council of Canada (“CCC”). The Board grants CCC’s late request for intervenor status and finds that CCC is eligible for a cost award.
