DECISION ON INTERVENTIONS AND COST AWARD ELIGIBILITY

The Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") issued its Notice of Application (the "Notice) in regards to the proposed expenditure and revenue requirements and the fees of the Independent Electricity System Operator (the "IESO") which it proposes to charge for the year 2011. The Notice indicated that cost awards would be available to eligible parties in relation to their participation in this proceeding, and asked that parties include the grounds for their cost award eligibility as part of their intervention requests.

The Board received intervention requests from 9 parties as indicated in the table below. As shown, 4 of the parties also requested cost award eligibility.

The Board approves all of the 9 intervention requests. Also, the Board has determined that VECC, Energy Probe, AMPCO and CME are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's Practice Direction on Cost Awards.

Please note that the Board expects all cost eligible intervenors to cooperate to the maximum extent possible to avoid duplication and also to restrict participation to issues that are within the scope of this proceeding. A Board-approved issues list will be developed as part of this proceeding.
