**Stakeholder Review of Ontario Energy Board's Business Plan for 2011 - 2014**

The Electricity Distributors Association (EDA) is the voice of Ontario's local distribution companies (LDCs). The EDA represents the interests of over 80 publicly and privately owned LDCs in Ontario.

The EDA endorses the draft Ontario Energy Board's Business Plan for 2011 – 2014 and notes that the proposed goals outlined in the plan are likely to have a large impact on electricity distributors and their customers. Therefore, the EDA requests the Board to allocate adequate time for each of the consultations the Board intends to undertake during this planning period so that electricity distributors and other stakeholders can thoroughly examine several complex issues in providing quality feedback to the Board.
