Re: Application by Iccon Transmission, Inc. (Iccon) for an Ontario Electricity Transmission Licence

Enclosed is Iccon's Application for an Ontario Electricity Transmission Licence pursuant to sections 57 and 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*.

Iccon is member of the Isolux Corsán Group of Companies. Iccon does not currently own or operate transmission assets in Ontario. The purpose of Iccon's application is to qualify Iconn to participate in the Board's *Framework for Transmission Project Development Plans*, EB-2010-0059.

Iccon seeks a temporary exemption from section 3 of the Board's *Electricity Reporting and Recordkeeping Requirements* until such time as Iconn becomes licensed and owns or operates transmission assets in Ontario. This request for a temporary exemption is consistent with the Board's acknowledgement in EB-2010-0059 that some of the requirements of a transmission licence may not apply unless a transmitter has assets in Ontario.

Iccon also requests, pursuant to Rule 10 of the OEB Rules of Practice and Procedure and the OEB Practice Direction on Confidential Filings, that the corporate organization chart for the Isolux Corsán Group of Companies, referenced in section 7(b) of the enclosed Application, be filed and maintained in confidence by the Board. The corporate organization chart shows internal corporate relations and structures that are confidential and are of a commercially sensitive nature. These relations and structures concern Isolux Corsán's business planning processes and strategies. Disclosure of this information to Isolux Corsán's competitors could cause harm to Isolux Corsán. Also, the relevant affiliates in the Isolux Corsán's corporate organization chart is marked "Confidential" and is enclosed as a separate document for the purpose of being filed and held in confidence.

Finally, Iccon requests that the Board determine this application by way of a written hearing.

Enclosed is Iccon's \$800 application fee.
