Union Gas requesting a takeover of Tipperary Gas's shares creates a greater monopoly of gas storage in Ontario by Union. It seems Tribute and Union conspired to shutout Northern Cross's proposed bid for a storage project in the northern part of Huron County and pipeline capacity to benefit Union's supremacy in the storage market. In my interrogatory of Sept. 20 2006 in Procedural Order #2 of File No. EB-2006-0018 and EB-2006-0159 I asked "Does the applicant have sufficient manpower and financing committed today to complete both projects". Tribute's answer was "Yes". In previous hearings Tribute promoted a Mr. Crich as being a prime investor. Now in Union's application to the Board they acknowledge "Tipperary Gas requires additional financing to complete the development of the Storage Pools". It seems strange to me the additional financing is 75% of the project. Tribute got Storage privileges from the Board under the pretence as being an independent operator when all the while Union is sitting in the wings to further their monopoly of the Storage market.

Union states that the "RP 2003-0253 proceedings provided details of all aspects of the development". All of the pipeline construction was to be within the road allowance. Howard Jordan representing Tribute asked me if I would allow the contractor's to put some of the dirt on my property. I cautioned him about my field of alfalfa. ALL the extracted dirt was placed on my property plus dozer tracks beyond the mounds of soil plus destruction of a section of my alfalfa. More false representation on Tribute's part?

In Union's defence, their involvement in the development of the Storage Pool has to be better than the "Keystone Cops" like approach currently being employed.

On the grounds of my property having a restriction placed on it by this development without compensation, I wish to seek costs if the Board deems necessary.
