## RE: Ontario Energy Board Smart Grid Implementation Stakeholder Consultation Board File No: EB-2011-0004

The Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") issued a letter to all licensed Electricity Distributors and other Interested Parties, dated January 13th, 2011, in respect of an initiative to develop a consultation process to examine issues associated with the implementation of Smart Grid in Ontario.

In such letter, the Board indicated that it intends to establish a Smart Grid Working Group ("SGWG"), to assist the Board: i) in gaining a better understanding of the associated technical issues and ii) in considering the need for and nature of policies or measures that could address those issues.
