Re: Hearing on Board's own Motion to Review Orders made June 29, 2007

Natural Resource Gas Limited Board File No. EB-2010-0374

As the Board and all parties and intervenors are aware, the Town of Aylmer took part in the proceedings that are the subject of this Motion to Review the Orders of June 29, 2007, although it was not represented by counsel at that time. The Town has been copied on all proceedings in this Motion to Review, but had not intended to take any position until the developments with respect to the appeal by NRG to the Ontario Divisional Court (the "Franchise Appeal") which are referred to in Mr. Stoll's letter herein dated January 26, 2011.

As counsel for the Town in the Franchise Appeal, we write simply to advise that the Town supports the positions taken in Mr. Stoll's letter of January 26, 2011.

In particular, the Board should be aware that the suggested linking of this Motion to Review with the Franchise Appeal was raised by counsel for NRG, and the adjournment of the Franchise Appeal was at NRG's request. The Town agrees that the Board should be aware of these developments in its determination of the issues raised herein. The Town also agrees that, given the limited, procedural nature of the review being undertaken by the Board herein, care should be taken by the Board to avoid any unintended impacts on substantive matters that may affect other

parties and proceedings, and in particular the Board's own decisions that are under review in the Franchise Appeal (EB-2008-0413 dated May 5, 2009, and EB-2010-0062 dated May 11, 2010).
