Re: EnWin Utilities Ltd. - Exemption from Mandated Time of Use Pricing Date for RPP Customers - Request for Extension of Filing of All Submissions Board File No.: EB-2010-0367

EnWin Utilities Ltd. ("EnWin") filed an application dated December 9, 2010 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B) for a licence amendment granting an exemption in relation to the mandated date for the implementation of Time-of-Use ("TOU") pricing rates for Regulated Price Plan consumers.

EnWin's mandated TOU pricing date is June 2011 and it has requested a new TOU date for all of its customers of December 2012, an 18 month delay. Enwin filed responses to Board staff interrogatories on January 27, 2011. Board staff requests additional time to review these materials prior to filing their submission. Board staff notes EnWin's application is the longest extension requested for a utilities' entire customer base. In addition, the evidence filed by EnWin as to why the exemption is required is more complex than other TOU exemption applications before the Board.

The Notice of Application and Written Hearing stipulates all submissions on the application are due by February 3, 2011. For the reasons described above Board staff

requests all submissions on the application be filed by February 17, 2011 and EnWin's reply submission be due by March 3, 2011.
