DECISION AND ORDER

On November 18, 2010, 6732976 Canada Inc. (operating as Pod Generating Group) filed an application with the Board under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, for an order of the Board to amend its electricity generator licence EG-2007-0684 to reflect changes to the list of facilities listed on Schedule 1.

Specifically, the applicant requested the removal of three generation facilities (PGG003, PGG004 and PGG005) from the list of facilities on Schedule 1 of its licence. According to the application, the applicant has recently sold the development rights for those generation projects to Starwood SSM2 Canada Incorporated ("Starwood"). Starwood has applied to the Board for a generation licence to own and operate the subject facilities.

There are no other changes requested to the licence apart from the aforementioned requested change to Schedule 1. All other provisions remain the same.

I have proceeded without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding and the applicant has requested that the matter be disposed of without a hearing.

I find that the information provided in the application is sufficient to demonstrate that granting the requested amendments is in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Schedule 1 of 6732976 Canada Inc.'s (operating as Pod Generating Group) electricity generator licence EG-2007-0684 is amended as requested to remove reference to PGG003, PGG004 and PGG005 from the list of its licenced generation facilities. The amended licence is attached to this Order.
