Re: Mandatory Time of Use Extension Application (EB-2010-0367)

On January 27, 2011, EnWin filed its responses to Board Staff's interrogatories. On February 3, 2011, the day that submissions were due from Board Staff, Board Staff requested a 2 week extension to February 17, 2001.

In the request, Board Staff made various assertions. EnWin takes issue with Board Staff's assertion that "the evidence filed by EnWin as to why the exemption is required is more complex than other TOU exemption applications before the Board." The issue driving the exemption request was a business decision to deploy a Comprehensive SAP ERP system; a decision made over a year before the Mandatory TOU date was set. The application and interrogatory responses detail that issue. The issue, application and interrogatory responses closely resemble the materials in EB-2010-0307, the FortisOntario proceeding. In that proceeding, Board Staff considered the evidence and made its submission in support of the exemption within the 1 week period following interrogatory responses.

That noted, this is a very important proceeding for EnWin. If Board Staff requires additional time to consider its submission, then so long as that delay does not prejudice EnWin or its ratepayers, EnWin does not oppose the request.
