In regard to Ontario Energy Board correspondence dated December 7, 2007 I have attached a response to all questions as directed:

In Reference to the 2008 IRM Model: Sheet 3

1. Monthly Rates and Charges for Large Use

A review of St. Thomas' current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that for the Large Use class, the entry for Retail Transmission Rate – Network Service Rate and for Retail Transmission Rate – Line and Transformation Connection Service Rate both include the descriptor “Interval Metered”, however St. Thomas' 2008 model does not reflect this.

St. Thomas Energy Response: The following wording “– Interval Metered” should have been included after each description line: a) “Retail Transmission Rate – Network Service Rate” and b) “Retail Transmission Rate – Line and Transformation Connection Service Rate”. This was inadvertently left out.

2. Monthly Rates and Charges for Unmetered Scattered Load

A review of St. Thomas' current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the Unmetered Scattered Load class is applied on a "per customer" basis, however St. Thomas' 2008 model does not reflect this.

St. Thomas Energy Response: The following wording "(per customer)" should have been included after the description line of "Service Charge". This was inadvertently left out.

3. Monthly Rates and Charges for Sentinel Lighting

A review of St. Thomas' current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the Sentinel Lighting class is applied on a "per connection" basis, however St. Thomas' 2008 model does not reflect this.

St. Thomas Energy Response: The following wording "(per connection)" should have been included after the description line of "Service Charge". This was inadvertently left out.

4. Monthly Rates and Charges for Street Lighting

A review of St. Thomas' current 2007 Board approved Tariff of Rates and Charges indicates that the service charge for the Street Lighting class is applied on a "per connection" basis, however St. Thomas' 2008 model does not reflect this.

St. Thomas Energy Response: The following wording "(per connection)" should have been included after the description line of "Service Charge". This was inadvertently left out.
