This letter is further to our letter of February 17, 2011, enclosing the Cost Claim of our client, Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters (“CME”). That letter was written on the mistaken premise that the total cost award allowance was 47 hours shown in Attachment B to the Board’s letter of August 20, 2010.

Mr. Aiken has brought to our attention that the total allowance is, in fact, 57 hours, taking into account the Board’s subsequent allowance of an additional 10 hours for written comments by November 2, 2010.

In the result, our Cost Claim exceeds the total allowance by 5.5 hours, rather than the 15.5 hours described in our letter of February 17, 2011.

We received copies of letters to the Board from counsel for the SEC, Mr. Quinn, and Mr. Aiken. Those letters demonstrated what we anticipated in our letter of February 17, 2011, that the Cost Claims of the intervenor group that retained Mr. Rosenkranz would fall well within the limits of the envelope amounts the Board established with respect to this proceeding.

On the basis of that correspondence, we reiterate our respectful request that the total amount of time that this firm spent on this matter of 62.5 hours be allowed.
