Per the Board's Decision and Order regarding the Late Payment Penalty Generic hearing (EB-2010-0295) issued February 22, 2011, Kingston Hydro Corporation (referred to in Appendix A of the Decision and Order by its former name, Kingston Electricity Distribution Ltd. 142446 Ontario Ltd.) is listed as one of the "Affected Electricity Distributors" and as such has been approved a recovery amount that represents their share of the class action costs.

As directed in the Order, please find attached "Appendix A: LPP Rate Riders" for Kingston Hydro Corporation that are based on the calculation methodology outlined in the Decision. Relevant RRR data and the calculations used to derive the LPP rate riders are provided.

Kingston Hydro Corporation's share of LPP class action costs approved for recovery per Appendix A of the Board's Decision and Order (EB-2010-0295) is \$104,031.09.

LPP Rate Rider Sunset Date: April 30, 2012
