Re: EB-2011-0030: ABW Solar General Partnership Application for an Electricity Generation Licence

We are counsel to ABW Solar General Partnership ("ABW"), the applicant herein.

We write in response to the Board's Letter of Direction dated February 24, 2011 (the "LOD"). In particular we reference the LOD directions provided to ABW to post the Notice of Application and Written Hearing (the "Notice") issued therein on ABW's website, "*if available*", and to advise the Board Secretary when the Notice has been so posted.

As noted in the addendum provided as part of ABW's application to the Board dated January 28, 2011, ABW was only formed as of December 23, 2010. ABW does not currently maintain a website.
